## Did You Know.....

The City of Hastings City Council adopted a new Utility Service Policy on April 11, 2022.

Highlights of the new policy are as follows:

- Payments not received by the City by 4:00 PM on the due date are delinquent.
- Postmarks are not accepted.
- A 10% penalty will be added to any unpaid current balance after the due date.
- A \$50 Delinquent Bill fee is added to all accounts with a past due balance after the due date.
- Payments may be made by Auto Pay, Mail, Drop Box, Online, by phone or in person at City Hall.
- There is no fee for payments made by Cash, Check, Money Order or Auto Pay.
- Credit/Debit or E Check payments will be charged a service fee by our third-party affiliate.
- Payment arrangements for customers with a shut off notice will now be limited to 5 days beyond the due date and must be requested before the due date.
- Customers requesting a 5 day payment arrangement must not have had their service disconnected for non-payment in the most recent 12 months.
- Payment arrangements are now limited to two payment arrangements in the same 12 month period.
- Once disconnected, utility service will not be restored until all past due charges are paid in full.
- Disconnected accounts turned on after hours (after 2:30 PM) will incur additional charges and must be paid in full prior to reinstatement of services.

**We are accepting:** Household Hazardous Waste Including aqueous acids and bases; oil-based paints; reactives; solvents; aerosol cans; automotive liquids; pesticides (liquids and solids); automotive batteries; alkaline, nickel-cadmium and/or silver oxide batteries; liquid cleaners; heavy metal solutions; mercury-containing articles; motor oil (**limit 10 gallons per vehicle**).

**Medications need to be in their original containers with the name of the drug clearly labeled. Cross out any personal information on the containers.**

Tire Drop-Off is free thanks to a grant from the Department of Environmental Quality. This is a one time only free tire-drop off event. **Limit of 10 tires per car, household tires only (no business tires).**

**We cannot accept:** asbestos; electronics, latex paint (when dry it can go to the landfill); propane tanks; commercially generated waste; radioactive material; explosives; unknown wastes; con-sole and projection televisions; speakers in wooden cases; tires heavily caked with dirt.
